

Applying for Conditional Historic Registration, (initially)

The vehicle MUST be as near as it can be, - to the way it was built, as per "code of practice" -- if it is LHD, it MUST have a letter of dispensation to allow it to be driven on S.A.s' roads, - before your verification person will even look at it. This letter Must be carried in the vehicle at all times.

Present your vehicle to the clubs verification person,

If it complies with the "code" , and you must declare any changes from original, on the top portion of the MR334 form, - - he / she will issue an MR334 which you present to a Service SA, branch - - on being granted Historic Registration, take the reg. Certificate to your clubs logbook person, he / she will stamp, date, and sign it, and issue you with a valid logbook, from then on , you may use that vehicle for 90 days in any one registration (12 months) period .. – You MUST make entry in the logbook (in ink) before You leave home, that entry lasts until midnight of that date..
